

SPINACH SCRAMBLE – LOUISE FOSTER

INGREDIENTS:

½ cup chopped Celery
½ cup chopped Onion
Small amount of Bacon Drippings or Butter
1 pound Hamburger Meat
2 cloves Garlic, chopped
1 pkg. frozen Chopped Spinach
4 Eggs

DIRECTIONS:

1. Fry celery and onion in bacon grease.
2. When tender, add hamburger meat and garlic.
3. Let cook till the red is out of the meat.
4. Then add spinach and cook for about 5 minutes – till spinach is about done.
5. Scramble 4 eggs into the mixture.
